Each course is suitable for any person working in the coroners' office, either experienced or new to the role.

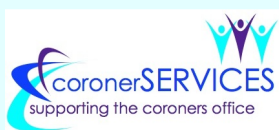

WHY ATTEND THESE COURSES  
With sufficient knowledge and understanding you will be able to ask the necessary probing questions to ensure that the coroners record of the death is thorough. In this way HM coroner may make a fully informed decision as to ordering a post-mortem and or holding an inquest.

On completion of the study days you will be able to:

- describe and explain the anatomy and physiology of the relevant body system and apply to the common diseases and disorders resulting in death
- justify conclusions concerning cause of death in the context of the medical certificate of the cause of death
- apply the principle of cause and effect carefully to a cause of death and begin to appreciate the complexity of factors associated with causes of death
- discuss the principle aspects of causes of death with medical professionals and bereaved people
